Commencing with the 2006 Winter Series and through the Spring/Summer Series of 2009, Tony has been entered in nine different series and events whereby he collected thirty-eight First place finishes, seventeen Second place finishes and two Third place finishes. In December of 2009, Tony proudly took home the championship flag for the Open Wing Kart Division at the Tulare County Kart Club.

Tony is extremely dedicated to his existing sponsors and makes every effort to promote them at each event. Tony provides his sponsors with weekly updates, photos and details concerning his public appearances. Tony speaks on a Motorsports Radio show numerous times, has appeared with his kart at numerous Sports Car racing venues, private Motorsports Club events, Car Show events, Motorsports Charity Fund Raising events to do meet and greet sessions with autographed photo sessions. In addition, on Open Wheel nights at the Ocean Speedway in Watsonville, Tony is invited to do a Parade Lap flying the American Flag from his Kart during the National Anthem.

Tony's father is his pit-crew chief and maintains Tony's QRC kart. His mother helps Tony keep up with his updates and both his mother and father travel to his events to support his efforts and those of his sponsors. Tony enjoys meeting the fans, signing autographs and speaking on behalf of his sponsors as much as he enjoys the racing itself. Tony's fans appreciate his professionalism and enjoy spending time with him off-track.

In addition to Tony's love of racing, he is an outstanding student, maintaining exceptional grades and study habits. Tony believes his education is vital to his long-term career in racing and works hard to excel in all areas his schooling.

Tony continues to train in Trinity Racing's simulators after school on a weekly basis and has seen great benefit in his skill level as he advances in series. He finished eighth out of three hundred twenty-five drivers in the iRacing Late Model Series proving practice is not only fun, but is hard work and has its benefits.
